MAKE CAMPAIGN AGAINST PARASITE ENEMY OF FRUITS

(United Press Leased Wire.)
 Washington, D. C., Dec. 9.—A campaign against the pear thrips in California is to be conducted next year at the Santa Clara, San Leandro and San Joaquin counties, the bureau of entomology, U. S. department of agriculture, men have already been sent to California to be on the scene of the pest. The insect is a troublesome little insect of the ground and fastens its eggs on the blossoms of the apricot, cherry and prune trees.

to the cherry and apricot trees, according to the experts who have been sent to California to investigate. Spraying has been found to be an ineffective method of attacking the pest, because it attaches itself to the blossoms of the trees as soon as it hatches out, and a spray solution strong enough to kill the insect usually kills the blossom. But, the insect enters the ground during the last two weeks of March, and apparently stays there the greater part of the year. It is here that the scientists, who have been sent to California, hope to do their best work against the pest. It was learned here today that additional appropriations of \$15,000 will be asked for at this session of congress for the express purpose of fighting the thrips in California. The congressmen from Oregon will also ask for an appropriation of \$10,000 to be expended in fighting the codling moth in Southeastern Oregon.

ACTRESSES NAMED IN GOULD DIVORCE

 New York, Dec. 9.—Miss Marjorie Stevens and Miss Rose Winter, the latter an English actress, whose husband is Percy Winter, were named today as co-respondents in the suit for divorce filed by Mrs. Helen Kelly Gould against Frank J. Gould. The plaintiff alleges that, during the fall and winter of 1906 and 1907, Gould and Miss Stevens occupied adjoining rooms at the Grand Hotel in Paris and that, afterwards, he frequently visited the young woman at her New York residence. Mrs. Gould charges that her husband, by paying court to Miss Winter in this city, meeting her at a well-known restaurant in 1906 and afterwards lavishing costly presents and sums of money on her.

ACCUSED OF THREATENING YOUNG LADY

A damage suit was filed in the circuit court yesterday afternoon by Fred Fogel, of Mt. Angel, alleging that the city marshal, Anjone Poepping, arrested him and caused his confinement in the city jail for a period of 29 hours without justifiable cause. Fogel demands that the sum of \$5,000 be decreed him for the unwarranted arrest. From information received from Mt. Angel it appears that Fogel formerly resided in Portland with his parents, and came to Mt. Angel several months ago. During his stay in Mt. Angel he became infatuated with Anna Heckerman, a young lady residing there. Upon a refusal to have anything to do with him, Fogel is alleged to have made threats against her which were sufficiently serious to warrant the marshal arresting him.

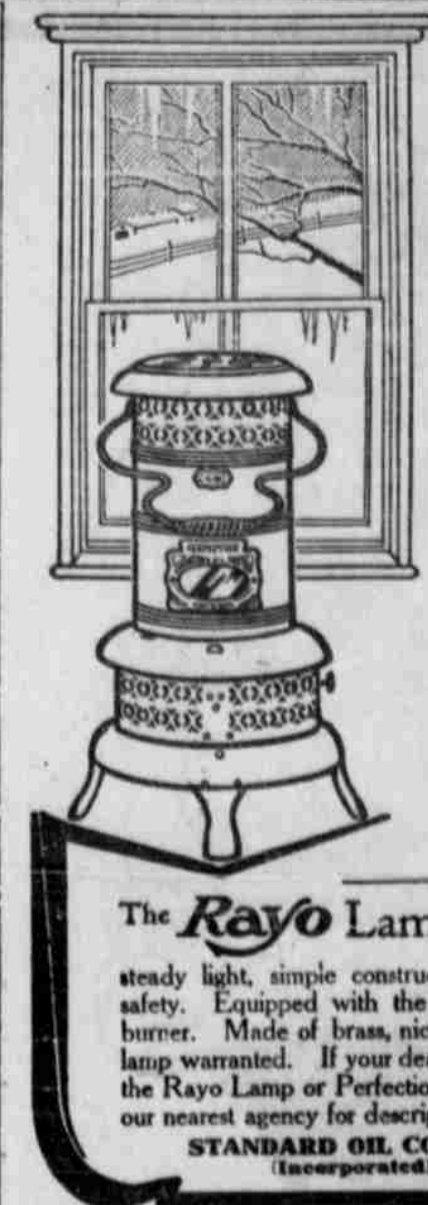

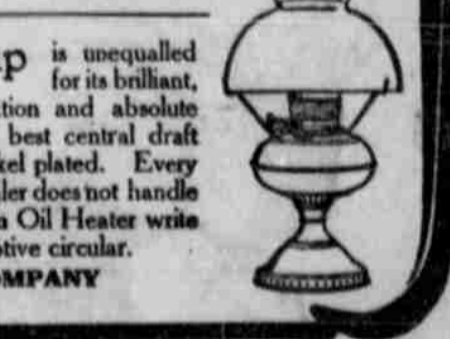
