THE STERN CHASE THAT WAS A LONG CHASE

[United Press Leased Wire.] San Francisco, Cal., April 12.—Ensign Walter Jacobs, U. S. N., is in this city today impatiently awaiting the arrival of the government transport Sheridan, which bears his fiancée Miss Winnie Dunlap, sister-in-law of the prosecuting attorney of Manila. When the young woman arrives the naval officer hopes to make her his bride, and end an aggravating game of tag which the young couple have played for the past two years, and which led them across oceans and continents.

While Jacobs was in Manila, attached to the U. S. S. Chattanooga, in April, 1907, he met Miss Dunlap, and they were engaged to be married. The following month the young ensign was called into headquarters. Soon after his departure his fiancée decided to follow him, and sailed for New York. Upon her arrival there she learned that Jacobs had been sent back to Manila, and she followed him forthwith.

Back at Manila the determined maiden found that the chase was only begun. Jacobs had started around the world aboard the battleship Illinois, with the Atlantic squadron. She renewed the pursuit on the first steamer that touched at the ports made by Admiral Evan's feet.

Now the stern chase appears to be at an end. Jacobs has been granted a furlough. He arrived in San Francisco yesterday, and is at the Fairmount Hotel. Miss Dunlap, accompanied by Mrs. Joseph S. Evans, her matron of honor, is aboard the transport Sheridan somewhere on the waters of the Pacific, and will reach this city probably this week.

It is thought that the wedding will be celebrated soon after the big ship reaches its dock.

Mrs. Frohman declined to state on what grounds she has applied for a decree. "I don't care to talk about it," she said. "I only want the divorce as quickly as possible. I want to be married to the man I really love, and settle down in my own home to real domestic happiness.

"Why," she continued with a laugh, "I'm going to be as happy as I can be. I'm going to have 11 children every year."

When asked the reason of her San Francisco trip, Mrs. Frohman replied without hesitation: "I'm going to San Francisco to meet Mr. Bowes. I want to be near him until I get my divorce."
