

BRANDENBURG'S TRIAL BEGAN THIS MORNING

United Press Leased Wire. New York, June 15.—The trial of Broughton Brandenburg, novelist and newspaper writer, accused of grand larceny in the second degree in connection with the famous Grover Cleveland posthumous letters, commenced today.

Cleveland, widow of the late ex-president, appeared at the criminal courts building early today to attend the trial. Brandenburg appeared a short time later in company with Attorney Thomas. The author expressed confidence that he would be acquitted.

Brandenburg is accused of selling a spurious article to the New York Times during the last presidential campaign. He contends that the article was written by Grover Cleveland, as he represented at the time he sold it to the paper.
