WOULD IMPROVE PRISONER'S CONDITION

Chicago, Oct. 15.—Mrs. Ide, who has been interested in prison reform for several years, today started a campaign in this city, with the objects of having the inmates of the penal institutions transferred to a model convict farm in Cheyenne county, Colorado, 160 miles east of Denver.

Mrs. Ide proposes to secure legislation that will place the farm under the control of Illinois authorities. She declares that the convicts could make the venture profitable to the state, while at the same time the prisoners would be given the benefit of better conditions during their enforced servitude.

Mrs. Ide secured the farm, which contains 4000 acres, from Mrs. David Ellsworth Lucas, the wife of a prominent physician, who is interested in the reformation ideas propounded by Mrs. Ide.
