SALES OF HOPS TOTAL 2500 BALES

(Portland Telegram.) Heavy purchases of hops were made in this state again yesterday, the total running to over 2500 bales. Purchases of as many more bales are being given publicity, but they are all old, having been made from two to five days ago and previously reported, but not in specific lots. The prices paid yesterday ranged from 10 to 12 cents, and at least one of the lots taken at the latter figure was strictly choice, said to rank second to the best in The Dalles section. Orders are not coming in now as freely as was the case a while back, with the result that two or three of the dealers have withdrawn almost entirely from the market. Both of them stated that they might take a small lot today, but aside from this were out of it until they received orders. Hops are still being offered to Eastern brewers as low as 12 and 12 1/2 cents, July crop. A statement which has caused much excitement among the hop dealers and growers has been made, to the effect that it is impossible to import German hops for the reason that a blockade exists at Rotterdam. Nothing is further from the truth. Rotterdam is a neutral port and cannot be blockaded. Vessels entering that port are held up and their cargo inspected for the purpose of ascertaining if any of the cargo is for a belligerent. A vessel leaving with cargo for a neutral port has complete freedom and is not held up or refused passage to sea, as intimated. German hops have already arrived in this country, and more will follow. A. J. Ray & Son were the heaviest buyers in the hop market yesterday, purchasing 775 bales at 10 cents. Their big purchase was of the 700-bale lot of the Carstens and Banks Hop Company at Banks and the 55-bale Brentano lot at St. Paul. Klaber, Wolf & Ketter bought the 45-bale Hughes crop at Dallas at 11 cents and the 130-bale lot of Sinclair Bros. at 10 cents. Other sales reported include the purchase by the Seavey Hop Company of the Heinitz lot of 60 bales at Eugene at 11 cents, the purchase of 1000 bales by Harry L. Hart at 10 to 11 cents, including the 184-bale John Edmundson lot at Eugene; the Williams & Plummer lot of 270 bales at Dallas and the Resch lot of 79 bales at Butteville. McNeill Bros. bought the Frink lot of 51 bales at Dallas. The Gong crop of 215 bales of Salem was purchased by B. O. Shuckling at 11 cents, while T. A. Livesley & Co. is understood to have bought the Kitch lot of 175 bales at Jefferson at 11 cents.
