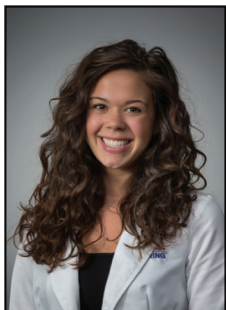
"The team is doing well,"
