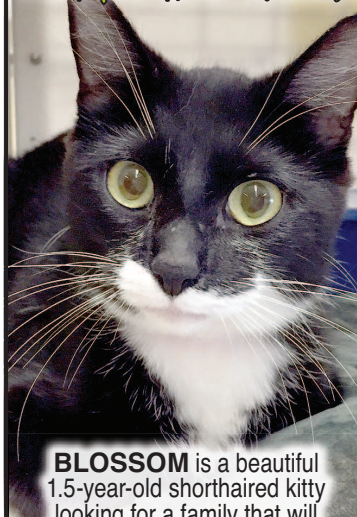
Story Times Begin in June
