

Sisters man killed in Fryrear Road wreck

Michael Anthony Graham, age 70, of Sisters, died Thursday night, June 4, when his 1996 BMW 328 convertible left the roadway as it was traveling north on Fryrear Road near Warrin Road, and rolled multiple times.

According to the Deschutes County Sheriff's Office, Graham was ejected from the vehicle and found on the side of Fryrear Road, near his vehicle. Graham was pronounced dead at the scene. There were no other vehicles involved or other occupants in the vehicle. However, a dog belonging to Graham was located alive and well at the scene.

Deschutes County Sheriff's Deputies were assisted by the Oregon State Police, Cloverdale Fire, and Sisters Camp-Sherman Fire.

Soccer camps will be big theme this summer, with SPRD contracting with UK Soccer, British Multi-Sports, and Park Soccer Tots to bring premium soccer coaches to the Sisters area. UK Soccer Camps bring a host of coaches who teach soccer the duration of the summer. The UK Soccer group will have two camps in Sisters this summer with a camp June 22-26 and August 3-7.

The British Multi-Sport Camp offers a medley of British sports including soccer during the morning hours and British sports like handball, cricket, rounders, netball, and rugby in the afternoon.

Both the UK Soccer and the British Multi-Sports organizations are looking for host families for coaches. Park Soccer Tots is a summer-long program for kids 18 months to six years old that gets kids out playing once a week from June 22-August 10. These classes have been professionally designed by Cascade Indoor Sports to develop

motor skills, promote physical fitness, and have fun.

Camps taught by local professionals and experts include the Outlaws Volleyball Camp, Tennis Camps, and PGA Junior Golf Camps. The Outlaws Volleyball Camp, taught by Sisters High School's new varsity head coach Jason Myhre, is scheduled August 10-12 at Sisters High School. Tennis Camps are returning this summer with Bim Gander, SHS boys varsity tennis coach, teaching a variety of one-hour sessions for beginners to returning advanced players.

Aspen Lakes is hosting golf camps during the month of July for junior golfers.

Adults sports will be going on throughout the summer as well. Women's Mountain Biking with Brittany Simonis started on June 4 and she is taking rides out from Blazin Saddles until July 9. Golfing for adults is also available with two options: either join the Community Fun Golf League that runs Wednesdays starting June 17 or take golf lessons with the Get Golf Ready Program starting Thursday, July 16. All golfing is taking place at Aspen Lakes and is being run or taught by their on-site golf pros.

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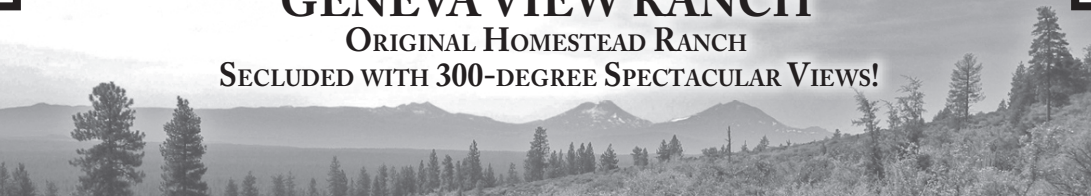
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
