Rikki (Glick) Heath topped the women's field in 22:17.

Finishers earned a T-shirt along with a pancake breakfast, and many walked away with prizes donated

by local businesses including Eurosports, Common Threads, Sisters Coffee, Sisters Bakery, Hop & Brew, Yo Bean, Martolli's, Latigo and Sisters Feed.

Race director Shawn Cummings considered the event a success and said he looks forward to a second annual race next year.

"I have never been in charge of a race before, but I learned a lot and I think people had a good time," he said.

Funds raised by the race will help support the flight science program at Sisters High School.
