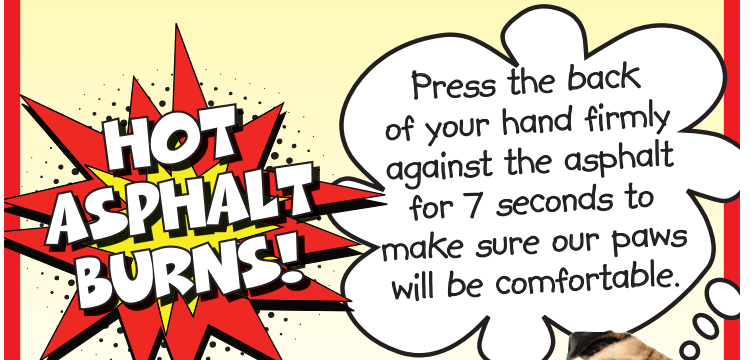

HOT ASPHALT BURNS!

The asphalt temperature has been measured at...

When the air temperature is...	77° F	→	125° F
	86° F	→	135° F
	87° F	→	143° F

These temperature correlations represent worst-scenario variables: direct sun, no wind, very low humidity, and high radiant energy.

At 125° F, skin destruction can occur in 60 seconds.
An egg can fry in 5 minutes at 131° F.
