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BBR police marks 25 years' service

Black Butte Ranch resi-
 dents, first-responders
 from across the region, and
 other well-wishers gath-
 ered last Friday to celebrate
 the 25th anniversary of the
 Black Butte Ranch Police
 Department.

Hank Fegette, who had
 come north to Oregon after
 a career in law-enforcement
 in Southern California, was
 serving as a deputy with the
 Deschutes County Sheriff's
 Office back in the late 1980s.
 He was covering Black Butte
 Ranch's law-enforcement
 needs with the help of some
 security personnel.

Fegette went back East
 on vacation and saw that the
 locality where he was stay-
 ing was a law-enforcement
 “service district.”

“I thought, well, there's
 no reason that wouldn't work
 at BBR,” Fegette recalled.

He brought the idea back
 with him, and Ranch CEO
 Dick Howells got behind it.
 The homeowners association
 voted on the formation of a
 service district and it passed
 with only three dissenting
 votes, Fegette recalled.

By July 1990, the district
 was in place, with Fegette in
 charge and five police offi-
 cers on the staff.

Since then, the BBR
 Police Department has han-
 dled security at the Ranch
 and conducted law-enforce-
 ment operations in con-
 junction with Oregon State
 Police and the Deschutes and
 Jefferson county sheriff's
 departments.

Gil Zacarro succeeded
 Fegette as chief, followed by
 current chief Denny Kelley.
 The department now has
 four officers, a sergeant, and
 an administrative assistant as
 well as a chief.

On Friday, Kelley
 reflected upon the depart-
 ment's roll in the community
 as officers grilled hot dogs
 and folks toured booths pre-
 senting emergency response
 information and listened to
 some live music.
