**ARREST:** Two teens acted alone in residential burglaries

Deschutes County Sheriff's Office arrested Jacob E. Glatz, 18, and a 16-year-old juvenile male for the residential burglary. While conducting the investigation detectives learned that Glatz and the juvenile male were involved in a previous residential burglary on August 27 on East Horse Back Trail in Sisters.

Glatz was booked into the Deschutes County Adult Jail on charges of theft by receiving in the first degree; theft by deception in the first degree; and conspiracy to commit burglary in the first degree.

The 16-year-old juvenile was booked into the Deschutes County Juvenile Detention Facility on two counts of first-degree burglary and theft in the first degree.

Detectives believe that Glatz and the juvenile acted alone in the two burglaries and there are no outstanding suspects.

In the Tollgate burglary, the suspect entered the house through an unlocked door. The sheriff's office reminds Sisters-area residents that it is important to secure doors at night and lock vehicles — basic precautions to avoid being an easy target.
