## Soup's On!



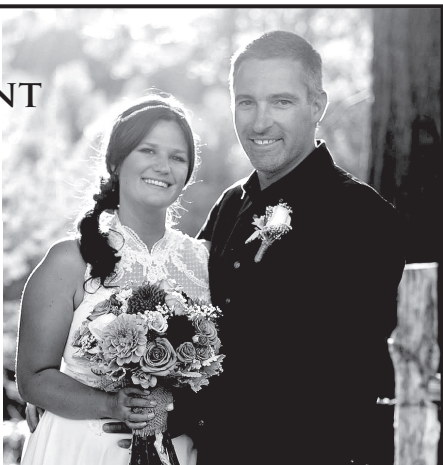
