instruction of prospective citizens and legal immigrants, education and educational facilities, and protection of the U.S. flag from physical desecration. Many of the American Legion’s core activities fall under the Americanism Committee; Legion Baseball, Boys State/Nation, Citizenship, Flag Advocacy, Flag Etiquette, Get Out the Vote, Junior Shooting Sports, Oratorical Contest, Scouting, and Youth Cadet Law Enforcement Program.

Gene Hellickson is a 20-year military retiree, having served four years active duty with the U.S. Air Force. He was awarded the Air Force Outstanding Unit Award, Air Force Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Air Force Longevity Service Award with 2 Oak Leaf Clusters, Air Force

Expert Marksman Ribbon, Airman of the Month 671st Joint Air Reconnaissance Control Center Radar Squadron, and Airman of the Quarter, 718th Aircraft Control and Warning Radar Squadron.

Gene was discharged as a Sergeant E-4. He served 16 years with the Oregon State Air National Guard, as a Radar Maintenance Supervisor and Maintenance Support Superintendent.
