January was colder than 'normal' in Sisters Country

Temperatures at Sisters averaged colder than normal during the month of January, according to preliminary data received by NOAA's National Weather Service in Pendleton.

The average temperature was 29.2 degrees, which was 2.5 degrees below normal. High temperatures averaged 39.2 degrees, which was 1.4 degrees below normal. The highest was 54 degrees on January 28. Low temperatures averaged 19.2 degrees,

which was 3.6 degrees below normal. The lowest was -6 degrees, on January 2.

There were 30 days with the low temperature below 32 degrees. There were five days when the high temperature stayed below 32 degrees.

Precipitation totaled 2.20 inches during January, which was 0.31 inches above normal. Measurable precipitation — at least .01 inch — was received on 8 days with the heaviest, 0.80 inches, reported on January 13.

Snowfall totaled 5 inches with at least 1 inch of snow reported on 5 days. The heaviest snowfall was 1 inch reported on January 4. The greatest depth of snow on the ground was 2 inches on January 4.

The strongest wind gust was 49 mph, which occurred on January 29.

The outlook for February from NOAA's Climate Prediction Center calls for above-normal temperatures and near- to below-normal

precipitation. Normal highs for Sisters during February are 44.3 degrees and normal

lows are 22.6 degrees. The 30-year normal precipitation is 1.31 inches.
