"Austin is our best player, but he shot a couple sevens and eights in the round, and you can't do that and be competitive," said Coach Bill Mitchell.

Andrew Mayes carded a 55/51/106, Devin Robillard shot 61/54/115, and Kade Owen posted scores of 51/63/114. Patrick Dingeman finished with 72/66/138.

Lake started out with a 47 on the front nine, and Mitchell told *The Nugget* he was excited about that and thought the boys might be able to knock off a couple of teams.

Mayes was consistent with a 53 on the front and back for a 106 total. Robillard started out well with a 47 on the front nine, which according to Mitchell was the best nine he's had in a few years. Devin added 14 strokes on the back nine for 61 and a 108 finish.

Mitchell said, "We did a little better overall, but the back nine was not good. The boys need to do a better job of course management. Instead of trying to hit the ball through the trees, they need to chip it into the fairway and take a stroke, rather than getting in more trouble and it costing them several extra strokes."

Mitchell told *The Nugget* that Andrew Mayes was the most improved golfer.

"This was Andrew's first year of competitive golf, and he really played some good golf against tough competition. His district rounds of 106/106 speaks to his consistency. He will improve and come out faster next season."

Mitchell added, "What I am most excited about ... is that the kids are already talking about where we can finish next year, and perhaps make a run for the state tourney. We have all our players returning so that's a plus, but they know they must work hard over the summer if they are ever going to figure out the game of golf!"
