and The Love Puppies.

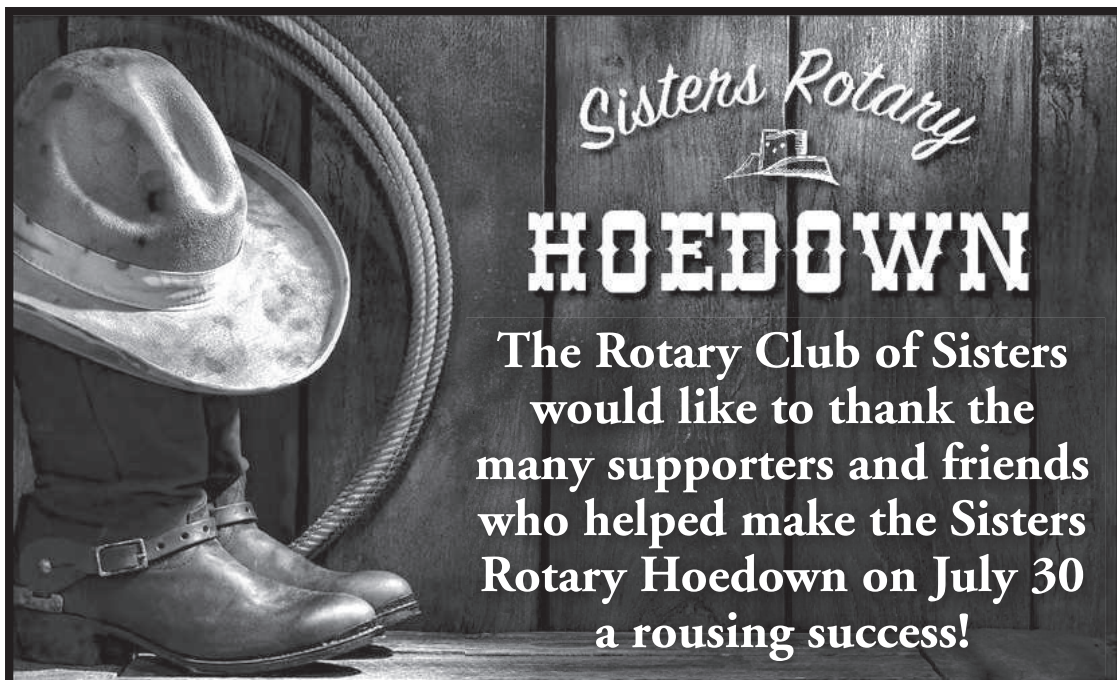
