Lions Club will host holiday faire

The Sixth Annual Lions Club Holiday Faire kicks off this Friday, November 25. The Lions Club, a national service club with a group here in Sisters, focuses on eyecare and hearing needs for the less fortunate in the Sisters area.

The Holiday Faire showcases handmade wares from 22 vendors. Items like soaps, scrubs, kitchen items, 18" doll clothes and accessories, Native American and Western-themed shadow boxes, hand-turned wooden ornaments, barbecue sauce, dog beds and more.

"I enjoy seeing people's crafts and sharing handmade gifts for the holidays," said club vice-president and one of the remaining founding members, Deri Frazee.

The eight-member club celebrated its 15th year this year and works with the national Lions Club philanthropy by helping with sight and vision as well as hearing.

Lions Clubs International was founded in 1917 and has been known to work on projects designed to prevent blindness, restore eyesight, and improve eye health and eyecare world-wide.

The local chapter, the Three Sisters Lions Club, works alongside groups like the Family Access Network to assist low-income community members with glasses, eye surgery and even hearing aids.

In addition to their work with the national philanthropy, the Three Sisters Lions Club also provides scholarships to Sisters High School seniors interested in attending a trade school or community college.

"All the money raised through the holiday event and other fundraisers we do stays right here in the Sisters community," said Frazee.

The Lions Club Holiday Fair is open seven days a week beginning Friday, November 25 through Sunday, December 18. Monday-Friday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.; Saturday, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday, 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.
