Student featured in campaign

Tanner Hosang, a student at Sisters Elementary School, is being featured this week as part of a statewide public education support campaign known as “The Promise of Oregon.”

The “Promise” campaign, which officially debuted in November 2014, aims to create public support for K-14 education, to help meet the state’s 40-40-20 goals and lift student achievement and graduation rates. New for fall 2015 and beyond, the Promise campaign is showcasing districts whose cutting-edge programs are preparing students for careers and college.
