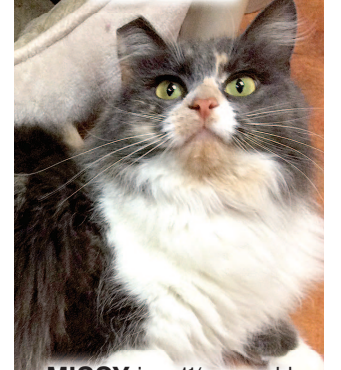
Help for Veterans
