

Outlaws play tough double-header

The Outlaws split games in the double-header against Sweet Home (SH) at home in Sisters on Friday, April 20. Sisters made a strong come-from-behind effort in the first game, but fell just short in the 8-7 loss. They turned it around in the second game and posted a 7-6 victory.

In the first game, SH started out quick. The Huskies scored two runs in the first, added a run in the second, and tallied three runs off a double in the top of the fourth to go up 5-1.

Sisters scored two in the bottom of the fourth, but the Huskies answered back with two and took an 8-3 lead.

Down by five, the Outlaws made a valiant comeback in the bottom of the frame. Singles by Taylor Fendall and Garrett Vohs, and a ground out by Austin Morss resulted in three runs. Fendall, Vohs, and Morss each recorded an RBI and Sisters closed the gap to 8-6.

The Outlaws managed to tack on another run in the sixth, but that would be it for the game, and the Huskies posted the win.

Zach Morgan pitched most of the game for the Outlaws. Zach allowed 10 hits and eight runs, struck-out five and walked one.

Sisters turned the tables in the second game, and tallied the 7-6 victory.

Pherry Luz drew a walk to score a run in the first, and at the close of the inning the Outlaws led 3-0.

The Huskies got their bats going, and scored three in the second and two in the third for a 5-3 advantage. After three-and-a-half innings, the Huskies were on top 6-4.

In the bottom of the fourth, Luz singled on a 3-2 count and scored two runs to even the score 6-6. Sisters' final run came in the bottom of the sixth, and the Outlaws held on for the win.

Luz and Morss led the Outlaws with two hits, and Fendall and Stutzman

singled. Luz and Fendall both recorded two RBI.

Sisters was to play at Sutherlin on Tuesday, April 24. They will travel to Elmira for a double-header on Friday

Firefighters douse brush fire in Sisters

It's April and the snow has barely stopped flying, but Sisters has already seen its first fire.

The blaze broke out on Sunday on Forest Service land just off Pine Street north of town (the dirt section of the roadway) near Trapper Point.

The fire was small — about 30 by 100 feet — according to Sisters Deputy

Fire Chief Tim Craig. Sisters firefighters quickly got it lined and doused with water from two responding engines.

The blaze was human-caused, Craig said, noting that he could make no further comment on the cause at this time. The fire serves as a reminder that fire season is upon Sisters Country, and caution should be exercised in forest and field.
