Members of the Sisters community can come together for a free Thanksgiving feast from noon to 4 p.m. on Thursday, November 22.

A cadre of community volunteers work each year to pull together the annual Sisters Community Thanksgiving Feast. The Sisters Community Church donates their location and the kitchen, and has for the last few years, for the group's use. Local vendors have donated other items like food and linens.

"All of the food this year has been completely donated," said event coordinator Jennifer Seher. "I don't think we have had to buy a single thing. It's been awesome."

Seher estimates that volunteers will prepare some 300 meals. All are welcome. Leftovers from the meal will be packaged up and taken to the Sisters-Camp Sherman Fire hall to feed the firefighters and paramedics who stay on duty to keep the community protected during the holiday.
