In addition to his mandolin lesson, Remington offered the students advice on how to be better musicians. He offered up advice on practicing their instruments, suggesting that, "When you practice you should practice in half-hour segments. Do five minutes of sight reading, 10-15 minutes of technique, 10-15 on new material, and 10-15 minutes just playing what you already know and what you'd like to perform."

He also suggested that students "take a song and learn it on every instrument you play, so you can connect the music inside to the music you play."


