

analyzing the project, we are pleased to announce the release of our draft environmental assessment of the project," said Ian Reid, Sisters District Ranger.

"I believe we will meet our goals of promoting fire resiliency and forest health; enhancing habitat for northern spotted owls, mule deer, and other important species; and providing forest products and recreational opportunities. During this public comment period, we welcome and encourage public comment on our proposal, including recommendations around which project alternative to select."

The project area has a history of mixed land-ownership until about 1943 when most of the project area became national forest managed by the Deschutes National Forest. Historic railroad logging, extensive clear-cut logging, fire exclusion and suppression, and wildfires have impacted the ecological conditions of the area.

The project proposes a variety of treatments in the area, including overstory and understory vegetation treatments, prescribed burning, road closures and decommissioning, and a trail reroute. In total, four alternatives were considered to meet the purpose and need of the project.

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District employees will be hosting a public field trip with stops to see different proposed treatment areas on Friday, October 29. RSVP for the field trip by calling the Sisters Ranger Station at 541-549-7700.
