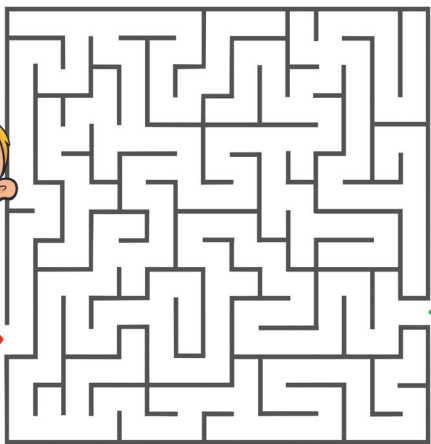

### Volunteers Needed

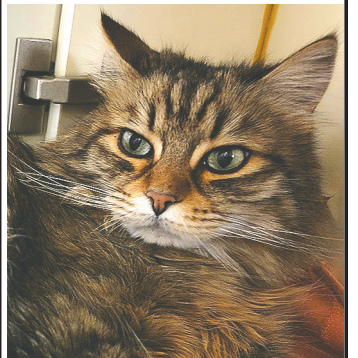
