The film presents the discoveries of anthropologist Luther Cressman, professor emeritus at the University of Oregon. Cressman's discoveries in the semi-arid Great Basin changed the whole theory of Western prehistory. Elizabeth Patapoff filmed Cressman in Eastern Oregon, following him from one cave exploration site to the next; she also includes archival footage that Cressman shot in the late 1930s, during the actual explorations.
