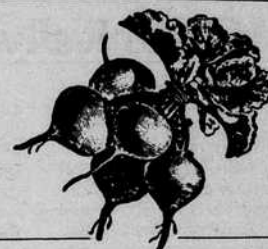


Vegetable Planting Guide for Lane County**
