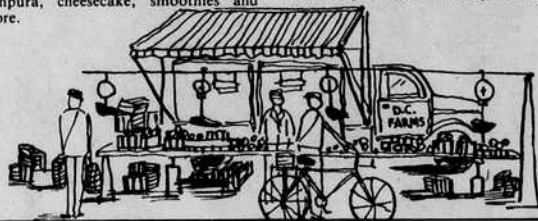

Local restaurateur Pat O'Connell didn't set out solely to take on "the Big Three" hamburger restaurants. The leader, McDonald's, has over 7 million stores and is currently opening 500 more each week! Pat has only one hamburger store, at 13th & High in Eugene, and his aim is quality—not quantity. Since adding indoor seating to their present location last winter, **Great Oregon Burger** has enjoyed continual monthly increases in sales. And there isn't a day that goes by when somebody doesn't comment, "... boy, that was good. ... the best burger ... I've heard you have the best. ...". With that kind of unsolicited endorsement, it's easy to understand why Arlene and Pat's four other employees feel so good about their work. They make everybody happy.

Pat didn't go to "hamburger college," in fact he had no restaurant background at all. Raised in Oakridge and Klamath Falls, he joined the Marines in the early 60's, settled in San Diego (working for soda pop giant Coca Cola), but longed to move back to Oregon. So in 1975 he returned to Eugene and joined the booming real estate business. Five years later he purchased the kitchen trailer that was to become the home of **The Great Oregon Burger Company**.



He opened for business on the site where it stood, next to the Sunny Station near LCC. Nine months later brother/partner Michael discovered and helped acquire their present location. Pat has added on twice since then, just recently to restore the outside seating that was sacrificed for the indoor seating. No matter where you like to eat them, Great Oregon Burgers are great—made from 100% beef with all the trimmings and served with individually prepared orders of french fries or onion rings. Each order is individually prepared and quickly served. You can avoid any wait by phoning your order in; 344-5221. They're open 7 days a week, 10 am till midnight.

Although Pat is looking to open more **Great Oregon Burger** locations in the future, he assures me that: "Quality will always remain the focus—we'll never become a hamburger factory."

Casablanca

Downstairs at the 5th Street Public Market, you can slip into the delightful and exotic atmosphere of a Middle Eastern sidewalk cafe, complete with Arabic music and decor. This charming and cozy hideaway, **Casablanca**, offers a wonderful variety of dishes for lunch or dinner, including authentic entrees, salads, dips, desserts and beverages.

Chef Ibrahim ("Ibby") Hamide dishes up interesting conversation as well as interesting ethnic cuisine, from the tiny kitchen behind the counter. And he's very willing to share the secrets of his trade. Fresh ingredients, including fresh herbs, and a personal touch are the keys to the quality fare. "We cook each meal separately and nothing is frozen," he says.

Hamide's personal touch and pride in his creations are evident in every aspect of the Casablanca experience. "It's not just food we serve," he says. "It's culture, hospitality, and lifestyle." And we found this to be true, in the elegant service and comfortable friendly atmosphere.

Chef Hamide has been in the restaurant business for years. Behind him are 12 years of French cuisine experience as well as his background in the foods of his native Palestine. He is a real professional who relates to his trade—the creating, preparing, and serving of food—as an art. And indeed it is!

One of my friends had the Shawarma—thin slices of lamb, broiled, and then cut into thin strips and topped with an exquisite sauce of tahini, herbs, and jalapenos. Each dinner comes with a salad, a dip, and hot pita bread. My friend chose the tabuli salad, which is a marinated mix of bulgher, parsley, tomatoes, cucumbers, and herbs, and the garlicky hommos dip—and both were delicious! She also enjoyed the Mediterranean drink, a refreshing fruit drink with rose water.

My dinner introduced me to a new and very interesting dish—the Samboocik, currently my favorite. It consists of beef, pine nuts, onions, and spices (cinnamon, garlic and others), rolled up in an eggroll-like skin and pan fried in butter. Is your mouth watering yet? I also enjoyed the cucumber salad in a creamy, tangy yogurt dressing, and the baba ghanouj (eggplant dip). The final treat of the evening was a slice of pistachio halva and a cup of Turkish coffee.

Casablanca is open from 10 am to 6 pm, 7 days a week, and til 8 pm on Friday nights. They also take reservations for special dinner parties after hours, offering 6-8 course candelit meals of your choosing. Phone 342-8411 for reservations and special orders. And, look for Casablanca at the Oregon Country Fair, July 8-10.
