Registration is now open for the University of Oregon's Community Piano Program. Instruction for children of all ages, as well as adults (including senior citizens) is available. The classes are designed for each age and skill level. Students improvise, harmonize, play by ear and learn how to play classical, folk and popular music. One of the highlights of the program is the elec-

tronic piano lab with individual headsets with which the student can listen to her/his own music, or the teacher can tune in to each student's playing, or duets can be played together, while others do whatever they need to do, like practice. Students learn a combination of playing, theory and also movement to enable them to integrate the whole music experience.
