Friesen, Stowell & Peterson

The jazz duo of David Friesen, bass, and John Stowell, guitar, will perform at Jo Federigo's on Friday, Jan. 18 and Saturday, Jan. 19, along with pianist David Peterson from 9:30 pm-1:30 am.

Friesen and Stowell, who have performed at major jazz festivals worldwide, have recorded six albums together, including *Through the Looking Glass*, chosen as one of the top ten best jazz albums for the 70s by the Los Angeles Examiner.

They have been described as storytellers on their instruments, producing music that is multi-colored in tone as well as imagery: "And the tales that Friesen and Stowell tell are like conversations between mystics and sages, each with its own philosophical kernel, its Zen twist." —Fred Bouchard/*DownBeat*.

Peterson, who also plays guitar, has recorded albums with Joni Metcalf, Diane Shure, and the Blue Sky Quartet. There will be a \$3 cover charge.
