



Sunday—Day of HOPE at the Hult



From morning til midnight this Sunday you'll be able to pick your entertainment at the Hult. From gospel early to jazz late, an all-day musical affair is planned, the focus of a \$200,000 fund-raising effort for Ethiopian famine relief.

Sponsored by HOPE, a branch of the McKenzie River Gathering, the event's proceeds will go to Oxfam, an organization that bypasses the governments of stricken areas and deals directly with local people, thus saving time and cutting costs. Over 75% of the money made will go directly for food for those victims of the expanding African desert.

The day will be divided into

four separate events. A morning invocation, with Ken Kesey, Brian Obie and several gospel groups, will run till noon. A \$5 donation is requested for this. After that, three concert programs will take turns in the Silva Hall. The first, of classical and jazz, features the Eugene Jr. Symphony, Windham Hill artists Michael Harrison, Ben Carlyle and others. The second, starting at 4 pm, has the Cashiers, the Crazy 8's and four other bands supplying the beat. The last, from nine till midnight, is jazz, with Nancy King, Shumba, Dan Siegal, Don Latarski and more.

The Hult has donated its facilities for the day, all the employees will be working

without pay, and the Hilton's giving room and board to the out-of-town performers. The tickets are \$7.50 for each event, or \$18.50 for the whole day—enough to feed a starving child for over a full month.

In conjunction with the Hult's music, there will be an all-day radiothon at the Hilton. Soliciting funds as MC of this adventure, with or without his white horse, will be local weather mis-forecaster, Dave Sweeney. The Clown Company, Shumba, the Whites-tones, belly dancers, jazz, fiddlin' music and midnight reggae will be featured. Admission will be by donation, and every dollar will help aid the over five million people in desperate need of it.


