Moliere at LCC

Opening at Lane Community College's main stage is Moliere's *The Doctor in Spite of Himself* (*Le Medicin Malgre Lui*), a 17th century farce about a woodcutter who impersonates a learned physician. His challenge is to cure the unexplained silence of a young woman. Broad humor and gentle satire mark this piece.

Director Stan Elberson makes use of masks and a horse drawn "pageant wagon"—devices reminiscent of the Italian *commedia dell'arte* which influenced Moliere.

David S. Bull (LCC's *Bus Stop*) plays the title role, with Sandra Williams (LCC's *Sound of Music*, *Bus Stop*) as Martine, his resourceful wife.

The play runs April 26-27 and May 1-4, at 8 pm. Tickets are \$5. Box office: 726-2202.
