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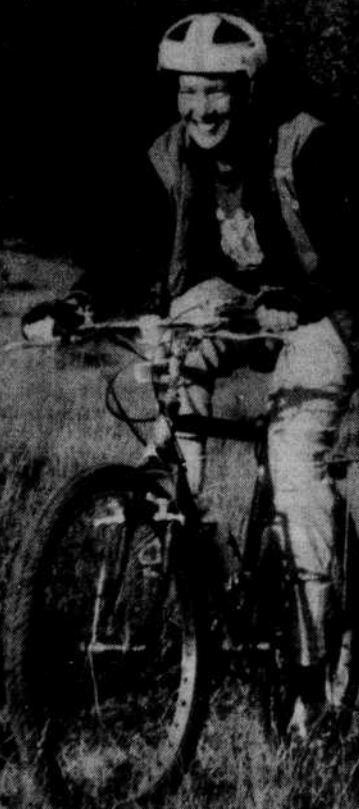

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Pacific States Mountain Bike Series



On Sunday of this week, Eugene will be the sight of the third leg of the Pacific States Mountain Bike Series, a series of five races near metropolitan areas on the West Coast. After Eugene, it goes to Seattle, then San Francisco.

During the event, cyclists will have the opportunity to test out an interesting hybrid in cycling construction—the mountain bike, a light-weight frame with heavy duty “fat” tires, ideal for touring off the beaten track. Schwinn will provide bikes for everyone who wants to enter.

There are two classes—the competitive Pro/Am class, for 15 miles, and the Sport class (approximately one-half mile) for the newer rider. There are prizes in both classes; top time in the Sport class wins a Schwinn High Sierra Bicycle. The Pro/Am class is both an individual and a series race. Series champ wins a trip to Japan and biking events there. There will also be drawings for bikes and other prizes.

On the morning of the race there will be technical inspections, clinics, and demonstrations of the mountain bike. Clinics and demonstrations begin at 9:30. The Sport class race begins at noon; the Pro/Am at 4:00. Starting point is Autzen Stadium. Call 687-8499 for more information.
