YANCI

The Community Center for the Performing Arts (WOW Hall) is bringing "the prince of mime" to Eugene Monday, July 1, at 8:30 pm. Yanci has been performing his one-man show in Europe for the past several years to critical acclaim. He's been described as a mime, a dancer, a clown, a magician, an actor, an acrobat, a writer, a director. In fact he is all of those. "Yanci is able to make his body do seemingly impossible things. He amused and amazed his audience," said Santa Barbara News Press. "With his feelings for brilliant comedy he is one of the world's best pantomimes," according to a leading Austrian newspaper.

He has adapted and directed Greek Tragedy, acted in films and on television. His play *Michelangelo* premiered at the Pacific Conservatory of Performing Arts in California where he is now resident actor/teacher/mime.

Born in Hungary, Yanci studied in Chicago and then was asked by the world famous French mime Marcel Marceau to join his stage show. Having worked for eight years with Marceau, Yanci ventured out on his own in 1980 taking his one-man show around the world.

Doors open at 8 pm Monday night. Tickets for the performance are available at Balladeer Music, Backstage Dancewear, Cat's Meow Records, Earth River Records, EMU Main Desk, House of Records, Literary Lion. They cost \$5 in advance, \$7 the day of the show. Call 687-2746 for more information.

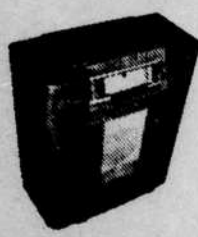
