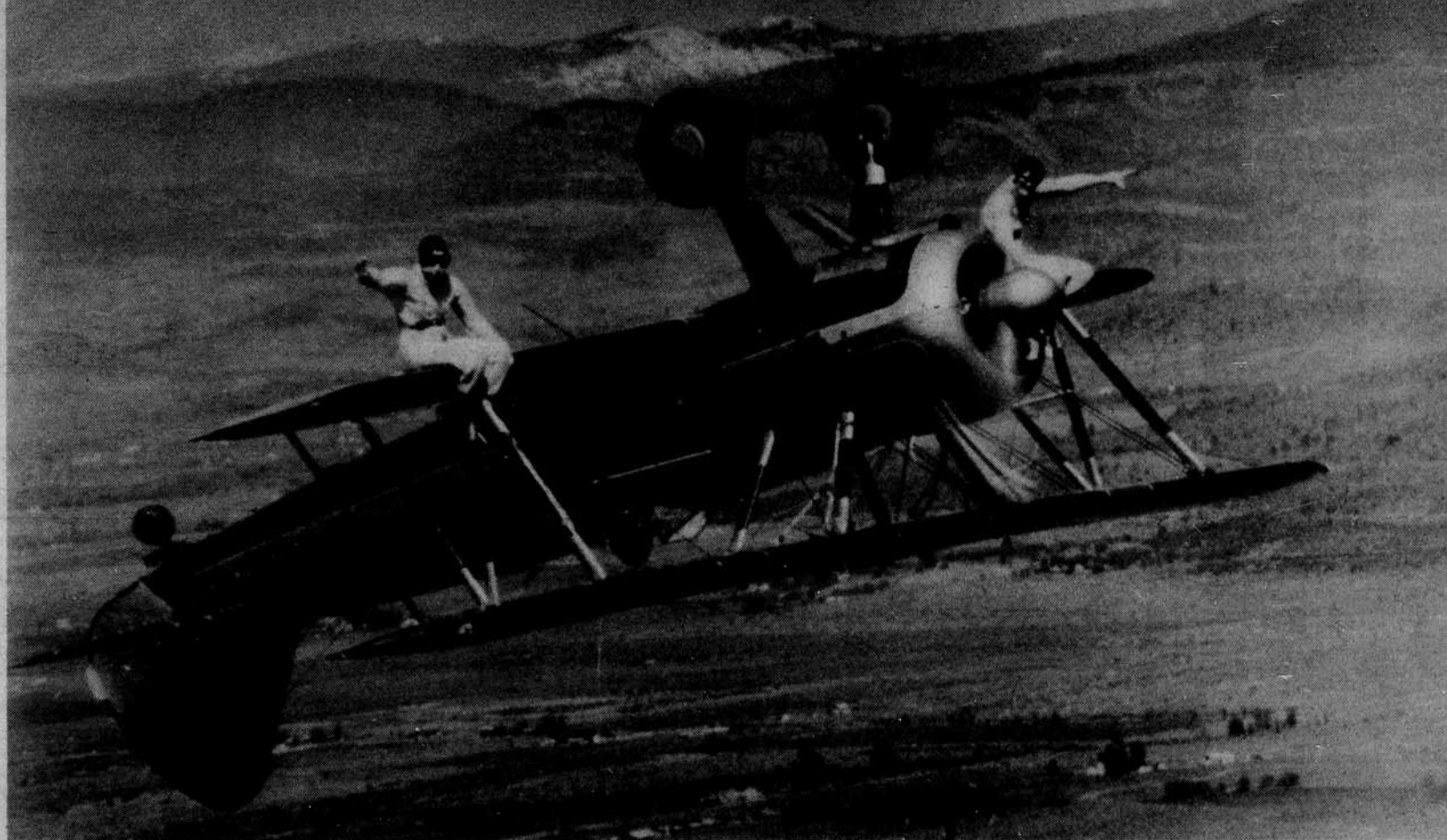

Creswell Air Fair



"Friendliest Air Show in the West"

This year's Creswell Air Fair is going to be a real extravaganza! Scheduled for Saturday and Sunday, July 27 and 28, this year's air show will feature daring aviation stunts, military flybys and a performance by one of America's most notable pilots. On the ground there will be a wide range of educational seminars, displays, entertainment for children and musical entertainment for all.

Bob Hoover, one of the featured air acts, has a flying history which includes unimaginable anecdotes and exciting challenges as a civilian pilot, military pilot, test pilot and air show pilot. The Great American Flying Circus will be back again by popular demand, with the world's only wingwalking duo, the "daring damsels of the skies." Their finale stunt begins with the wingwalkers hanging by their knees from the bottom wing of the plane. The pilot then rolls the plane to inverted flight, leaving the women standing upright above the upside-down airplane! Bridget de Saint

Phalle's air show routine will feature snap rolls, multiple verticle snap rolls, the torque roll, tailslide and vertical inside/outside eight.

Aviation groups will conduct a wide range of educational seminars designed to appeal to the general public as well as the "flying" public. Some topics are: "Learning to Fly," "Aviation Career and Opportunities," "Aircraft History and Development," and "Aerodynamics."

Clowns, magicians and puppeteers will entertain the children at the Fair. This year's musical entertainment will feature jazz, classical, rock and acoustic music (see music listing for details).

Displays and seminars begin at 8:30 am, Saturday and Sunday. The air show is scheduled for 5-8 pm on Saturday, and 1-4 pm on Sunday. Tickets are \$5 for adults, \$3 for students and seniors; children under seven are free. Fly-ins are available at a discount rate. For more information, call (503) 683-4946.
