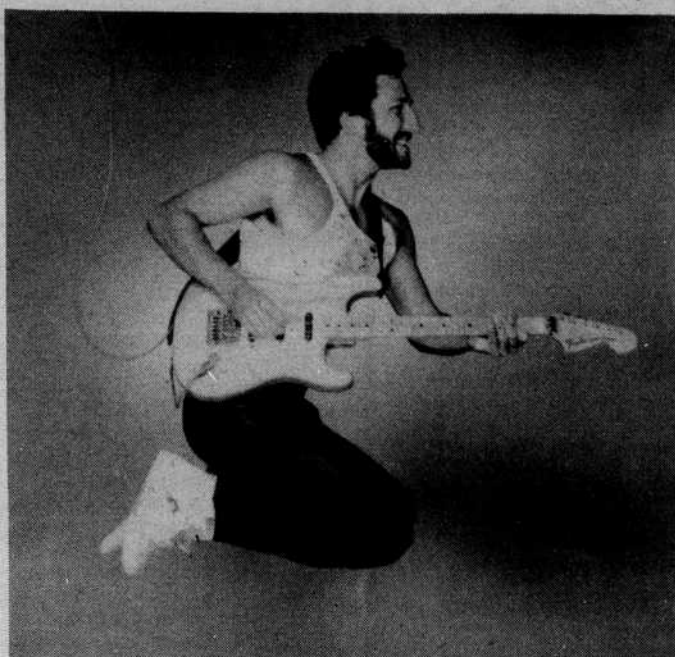

Richard Smith Returns

Former Eugene guitarist Richard Smith will be returning with his group The Richard Smith Unit for three nights at the Oregon Electric Station July 25-27.

The group features Richard's original compositions, which are a mixture of jazz, rhythm & blues and techno-pop elements. The group is made up of musicians from Seattle, Portland, Eugene and Los Angeles. Smith has been living in Los Angeles, where he is an Assistant Lecturer in music at the University of Southern California. He is also a freelance musician, as guitarist with the Dan Siegel Band, with pop artist Rockwell Scherer, and in studios around Los Angeles. He is featured as a writer as well as player on an upcoming LP by Steve Narahara.

Richard recently produced the music for a promotional video which featured Charles Haid

("Renko" from Hill St. Blues). His Los Angeles based group has played at the Bonaventure, The Biltmore, The Skylight and at the 1984 Summer Olympics Jazz Festival.

A graduate of the University of Oregon, Smith is completing a Masters degree in guitar performance from USC. He studies with jazz great Joe Diorio, as well as Steve Watson and Bill Kanengieser. He also holds a Clinicianship/Endorsement with Dean Markley String, Inc.

He will be graduating with honors from USC this fall. In May he was the recipient of the prestigious Jack Marshall Award for outstanding musicianship.

Richard will also be conducting a workshop on current studio techniques, modern jazz harmony and improvisation on Sunday, July 28, from 10-12:30, at McKenzie River Music, 525 E. 13th St., Eugene. The cost is \$15.
