The Pickle Family Circus is returning to bedazzle Eugene on August 10-11 with its one-ring variety show of clowns, jugglers, aerialists, and acrobats performing in the open air at Amazon Park to the always upbeat Pickle Family Jazz Band. Cascade Valley Waldorf School is sponsoring this year's Circus and hopes to make the event an annual celebration of children's culture in Eugene. Following the highly successful model developed by the non-profit Circus, a gala Midway comprised of over 20 local organizations—from the Junior Symphony to Switchboard—will offer food, games, information and free entertainment.

The Midway will be open from 11-7; the Pickles will perform at 1:00 and 4:00 each day.
