## Eugene Celebration PHOTO CONTEST

Children, cute animals, celebrities, clowns, coastal scenes and city lights—all could qualify as entries in the Eugene Celebration's first annual photography contest, "Faces and Places."

Both color and black-and-white photos can be entered, and all pictures must include a face or place from Lane County, OR. All amateur photographers are eligible to enter photographs taken within the last three years, and contestants need not reside in Lane County. Deadline for entry is Sept. 7.

Contestants will compete for prizes in either the "faces" or "places" category. First prize in each category is a Nikon FG 35mm camera with 50mm 1.8 series E lens, valued at \$300. Second prize in each category is a Nikon compact 9x25 and 7x20 set of binoculars. Twelve \$25 gift certificates for photoprocessing at

Dot Dotson's will be awarded as third prizes to winners from both categories.

Judges will be looking for originality, creativity and technical excellence. The five member panel of judges includes: Lane County Commissioner Jerry Rust; KMTR anchorperson Carol Donigan; professional photographer Charlie True; U of O professor of journalism Duncan McDonald; and graphic designer Mari Carmen.

First through third place entries along with honorable mention entries, will be displayed at the Hult Center for the Performing Arts during the Eugene Celebration, Sept. 27, 28 and 29. Top entries also will be published in *What's Happening* following the Celebration. Winners will be announced at a reception in the Hult Center, Sept. 25.
