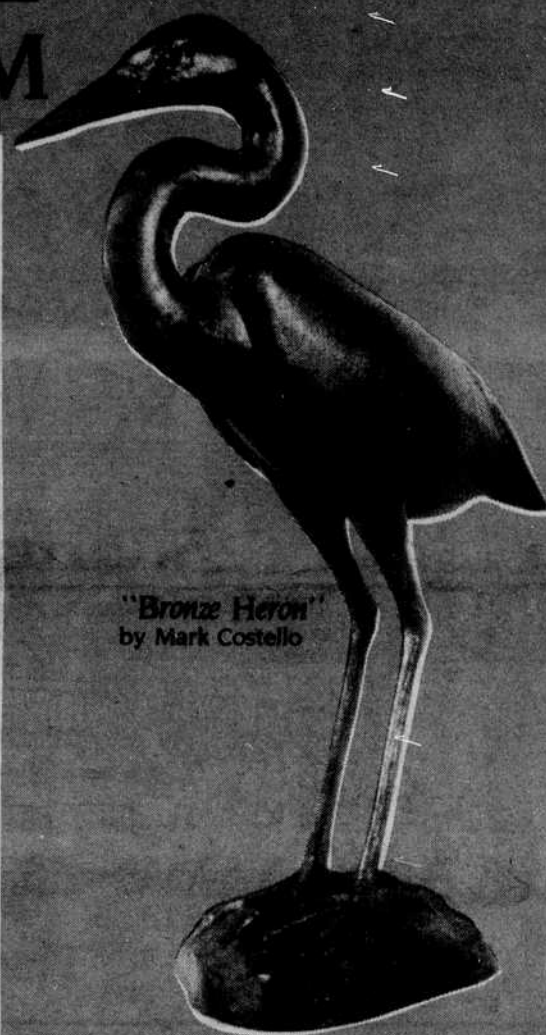
An opening reception to honor the artists will take place on September 6 from 7-9 pm at the Art Center. The public is invited to the festivities.
