Growing With Art

Ages: 3-5

Self esteem and expression will be enhanced by encouraging the children to create their own, individual, unique artwork. Clay, painting, printing, puppetry and construction projects will be inspired by stories, songs, an introduction to great art, and creative problem-solving "games". PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

Drawing and Painting

Improve drawing and painting skills, visual awareness and visual communication of ideas. Learning will be developed through an introduction to the ideas and art of important artists and art styles, through demonstration of techniques and media, and through practice. Techniques for looking at the sensory, expressive, technical and formal aspects of art will also be taught. The level of instruction will vary for each age group and to meet individual development. Stop by the Art Center to pick up a specific outline

of the concepts, skills and media covered in each five-week session, one week prior to the first class. PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

CHILDREN'S CERAMIC OUTREACH PROGRAM

Maude Kerns Art Center is now offering a ceramic program that will enable children to work on clay projects at home and have them bisqued, glazed and fired at Maude Kerns by our Children's Ceramic Coordinator, Kim Hance. We have prepared simple instructions and project ideas to make finished clay work possible for young children at home. OUTREACH PROGRAM COST is \$10 for members and \$12 for non-members per twelve pound bag of clay. Clay fee includes: a 12 lb. bag of clay; instructions; a bisque fire, glazes to use at home; and a glaze fire.

UPCOMING FIRING DATES FOR 1986 SPRING TERM: Purchase clay beginning 3/12. Bring greenware to be bisque fired by 4/9. Pick up bisque ware and glaze caddy between 4/16 - 4/28. For glaze fire deliver by 4/30. Pick up fired glazed ceramic between 5/7 - 5/28 in time for Mothers Day.

CHILDREN'S SUMMER ART '86 (July 7-August 15)

Maude Kerns Art Center is preparing its innovative schedule of summer art classes for children ages 3-16 years old.

This year the program will run three consecutive two-week sessions from July 7 to August 15. Classes are Monday-Friday at 9-11am, 11:30am-1:30pm, and 2-4pm. Childcare is provided before and after. Two fun lunch breaks with games and outdoor play in the courtyard are included.

The best art educators and art facilities in this area are available at MKAC each summer. Added to our regular summer program offering of painting, drawing, ceramics, print-making, film animation, photography, costume design, puppetry, mime and textiles are kaleidoscopes, felt and paper making and newer media. April 5 COLLAGE PAINTING

The focus of this collage painting class will be on interaction and unification through positive/negative cut-out relationships and color reflection and shadow inspired by the cut-outs of Henri Matisse and collages of Romare Bearden.

April 12 CARTOON DRAWING

Using pencil, oil pastel and watercolors, students will develop their cartoon idea in a three-dimensional relief format. Emphasis will be on expression of an idea through essential lines; exaggeration of facial features related to body posture; movement, and unexpected relationships.

April 19 CREATIVE RUBBINGS inspired by the CARTOON ART of SAUL STEINBERG

Students will investigate the sensory aspects of textures that surround us by translating them into visual experiences through rubbings. The potentials of combining varied rubbings and repeated images will be the focus of the project.

April 26 WATERCOLOR LANDSCAPES

Celebrate springtime with the beauty of watercolors. Learn to mix tube watercolors on your palette, by overlapping transparent washes, and by the spontaneous wet-into-wet technique. Students will learn to create space in real or imaginative landscape paintings inspired by the art of Paul Klee.
