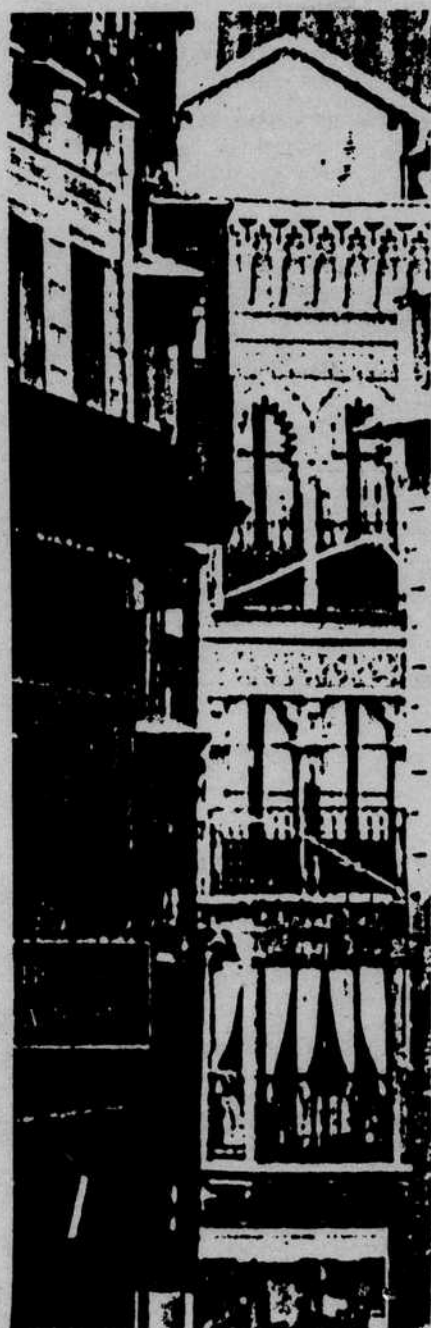




Maude Kerns Art Center

For more than thirty years, Maude Kerns Art Center has served as one of the leading arts centers in the Eugene-Springfield area. Named for Maude Kerns, an artist of international reputation and a university educator, the Center was established to provide a creative gathering place for both local artists and others interested in all aspects of fine arts.

Today, as a tax-exempt (501 C 3) Oregon Corporation, the Center provides local residents of all ages with an exciting and dynamic learning environment through its offerings of classes, workshops, exhibits, and special events.

Located in the oldest church building in Eugene, Maude Kerns is open to visitors and members, who may enroll in many quality education programs, or browse, free of charge, through our galleries and gift shop.

THE SCHOOL

Maude Kerns Art Center offers a variety of creative art classes that appeal to both professional and avocational artists. The faculty is comprised of local and visiting professional artists well-known for their expertise in photography, printmaking, painting, drawing, ceramics, jewelry, stained glass, calligraphy and the fiber arts.

Children's Classes

The Art Center offers young people — from pre-schoolers through senior high schoolers — the opportunity to pursue creative learning, exploring new techniques and using a variety

of materials beyond what is normally available in public school classrooms. Maude Kerns is the only art school for children in Eugene offering regular eight-week courses, drop-in Saturday workshops, after-school classes and "summer art for children".

Both adult and children's classes are limited in size to permit individual instruction, and students work side-by-side with some of Oregon's and Eugene's most respected visual artists.

THE GALLERIES

Maude Kerns houses three galleries — all under one roof. Each month, the galleries feature different exhibits by both local and Northwest artists, well-known established artists and new talent, and artists working in a wide range of media. Exhibits are on display for one month beginning with a public reception honoring the artists.

RENTAL AND SALES

The Rental/Sales program provides members with an opportunity to add to their home and office art collections, and provides artists with a source of income and visibility.

Since the Art Center acts as the artists' agent in arranging rentals and sales, artists are freed of the hassle of having to market their own work and thereby have more time to spend creating even more art.

GIFT SHOP

Our Gift Shop offers a variety of hand-crafted art works by Oregon artists. Gift selections include pottery, woven goods, jewelry, blown glass, books, paintings and prints. Visitors to the Center can find their favorite artists' works in the Gift Shop and discover new artists whose work they will enjoy. All media and all price ranges are available.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Maude Kerns Art Center hosts a number of special events each year to help increase our base of support and add to our annual operating revenue. Recent and planned special events include the Christmas Festival Sale with gala opening preview, an Art Auction in the Vineyard, the Cracked Pot Sale, Potters' "Olympics", and more.

STUDIO RENTAL/USE

Studios are available only during normal operating hours or with staff supervision. Class tuition entitles you to free term-long use anytime classes aren't in session. Consult with your instructor for more information on individual studios. Member artists who wish to work independently may rent studio space from Maude Kerns Art Center for \$5 a day per person when classes are not in session.

VOLUNTEERS

By design, Maude Kerns is a voluntary organization. Its success depends upon the work of many volunteers who contribute their time, energy and ingenuity. Over 200 volunteers regularly help care for the building and grounds, promote and organize special events, or serve on the Board of Trustees.

Maude Kerns is governed by a 16-member group of hard-working volunteers elected by the membership to three-year terms of office. Board members represent a variety of professional, business and community interests.
