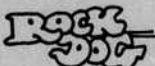

KRXX's "Rock Dog" wins award

The cartoon series *Rock Dog*, which appears every Thursday in *What's Happening*, was awarded a Gold Medal in the Broadcast Promotion and Marketing Executives' International Gold Medal Competition.

Out of a field of over 3,000 entries, roughly 100 medallions were awarded in various categories of radio and TV promotion. *Rock Dog* is the continuing story of a small dog who works as a part-time D.J. for radio station KRXX AM 1450. In this series, "Rock" has made fun of the station's astrologer ("Let me ask you an astrological question, Joe... you and me... we're both on the third planet from the sun, right?"), been made to dress in a tux, and blew up the Production Studio.

The cartoon was the brainchild of KRXX General Manager Richard Parker. When asked to comment on it he said, "I think it's great... I always knew the concept had great potential. I'm happy that the strip has now gotten its due recognition. And I think Paul Ollswang has done a tremendous job portraying the various activities involved in running a radio station."
