Our next weekly issue will be published on Thursday, September 18. Be sure to keep your present copy for the full three weeks!

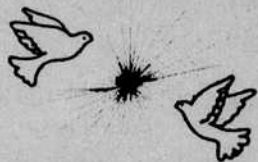

More-Than-A-Rodeo!

The Eugene Celebration has extended its activities with a two-day rodeo September 12 & 13 at Civic Stadium. It will feature 350 contenders for a purse of \$25,000.

"This rodeo is really more than just a rodeo," said Don Laird, chairman of the event. More-Than-A-Rodeo-Rodeo includes not only two evenings of rodeo competition, but also an old-fashioned country western barbecue, which will be held Saturday afternoon at the Amazon Park softball field complex, just across the pedestrian overpass from the stadium. Starting both evenings at 7 pm, the rodeo, sanctioned by the Professional Cowboys' Association, features professional cowboys who will compete in saddle bronc riding, bareback bronc riding, bull riding, steer wrestling, calf roping, team roping, and barrel racing. As a measure of safety to

horse and rider, the barrel racing will be held on the baseline area of the field.

Bob Tallman, world-renowned rodeo announcer, will call the shots and entertain the crowd from horseback inside the arena the duration of the event. Tallman is from Baker and announces over 300 rodeos a year in his unique style.

Other attractions include rodeo clowns, who create laughs while avoiding gaffs; mutton bustin' children who ride long-haired sheep; and a steer decorating competition for Eugene businesses.

Live country music will fill Civic Stadium before, during and after each show. In addition, a saloon on the grounds will tame even the wildest thirst. The rodeo will close with a grand fireworks display Saturday night.
