Now that election results are in, do you wish you could do more than put up lawn signs to influence the course of political events?

The American Peace Test is dedicated to applying the creative force of nonviolent direct action to the struggle against the nuclear arms race. The American Revolution, the abolition of slavery, labor organizing, women's suffrage, the civil rights movement, the campaign to end the Vietnam War, and the opposition to nuclear power all employed civil disobedience as an important and often central tactic.

The goal of the American Peace Test is a comprehensive Nuclear Test Ban which would: stop the development of new nuclear weapons; decrease dependence on first strike weapons; be a first, important step towards a complete nuclear weapons freeze; and be readily verifiable.

Immediate projects that you may want to find out more about include: a slide show and introductory lecture Saturday, Nov. 8 at 2 pm in Harris Hall (basement of County Courthouse) at 8th and Oak; a Nonviolence Training Session on Monday, Nov. 10 from



7-10 pm at Harris Hall in preparation for Nov. 17 when demonstrations will be held at the Nevada Test Site, in Washington, D.C., and in front of the Eugene Post Office at noon.

So take a break from your busy schedule and attend the free introductory session this Saturday. Becoming more informed can be an important first step in helping to share a world where peace is more than a dream some of us have.
