John Doan opens Hult Acoustic Series

Part of the emerging acoustic "Windham Hill" tradition, John Doan is a guitarist and composer whose compositions are considered modern classics. His Hult Center program on February 21 includes *Wake*, one of his most popular compositions which explores the enriched resonance and textural possibilities that developed from combining the features of the harp and the guitar. Also on the program are several of his works featured on the new *Windham Hill Guitar Sampler* LP that is being released this spring.

Doan is among the first to claim the harp guitar as a serious concert instrument. This turn-of-the-century instrument resembles a classical guitar, but the addition of unfretted bass and treble strings expands the range of the instrument and adds extra depth to its music. Played acoustically, it offers a sound at once new and old that appeals to contemporary listeners.

Doan recently performed several concerts in the Fujian Province of China as a cultural representative from the State of Oregon. He traveled with a delegation from Lane County headed by County Commissioner Jerry Rust. The trip was designed to help establish formal cultural ties with Oregon's sister state. *Reflections from China*, one of Doan's newest com-

positions, developed out of this cultural exchange.

Doan has lived in the Northwest for the past 12 years, serving on the music faculty at Willamette University and Western Oregon State College. He currently is one of the featured performers in the *Oregon on Tour* program sponsored by the Oregon Arts Commission.
