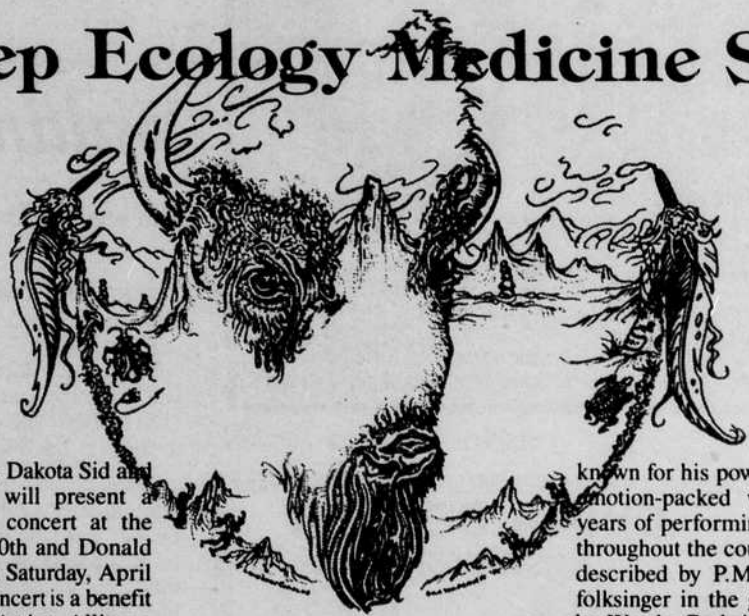

## A Deep Ecology Medicine Show



Lone Wolf Circles, Dakota Sid and Walkin' Jim Stoltz will present a unique multi-media concert at the Unitarian Church, 40th and Donald Streets, in Eugene on Saturday, April 18, at 8:30 pm. The concert is a benefit for the Kalmiopsis Action Alliance which is working to preserve old growth in the Siskiyou National Forest in southwestern Oregon.

Lone Wolf Circles, a poet and artist, fresh from the Anasazi pueblo where he lives in New Mexico, will share his evocative lyrics and "Deep Ecology" philosophy. His work stresses shamanic and mystical perception as the common spiritual root of all peoples and as the remaining hope of counteracting humankind's rapid devolution (destruction of the diversity and life of our planet). Wolf takes us from compassion to passion in an exploration of what Gary Snyder

called the "wilderness of the subconscious."

Joining him will be Dakota Sid, from the Sierra Mountains, providing rhythmic back-up and some of his own fine acoustic music as well.

Walkin' Jim gets his name from the nearly 15,000 miles he has walked over the past 12 years through the backcountry of North America, picking up songs and stories and taking pictures along the way. His show combines music and slides to express his sympathy and love for the Earth and the wild places he knows so well. Playing guitar and harmonica, Jim is


known for his powerful baritone and emotion-packed vocals. In his 14 years of performing, Jim has toured throughout the country and has been described by P.M. Magazine as "a folksinger in the grand tradition set by Woody Guthrie."

Tickets are \$5 and are available at Everybody's Records and Tapes and at the EMU Main Desk.

The Kalmiopsis Action Alliance is currently working to protect a vast old growth forest in the North Kalmiopsis Roadless Area, which borders the Kalmiopsis Wilderness. The stand is threatened to be sold for timber while the Forest Plan—which would protect the trees—is still being completed by the Forest Service. The Plan is two years overdue.


