His Eminence T'ai Situ Rinpoche is one of the four regents of the Kagyu lineage of Tibetan Buddhism. Born in 1954 in eastern Tibet, he fled that country, during the Chinese invasion, and was raised by His Holiness, the Sixteenth Gyalwa Karmapa at Rumtek monastery in Sikkim. Rinpoche is the twelfth T'ai Situ incarnation, and an emanation of Maitreya, Guru Padmasambhava, and Marpa. The Situ incarnations were the spiritual masters of the emperors of China, and have taught, and been taught by, the Karmapas. In this lifetime, Rinpoche is a tireless worker for world peace.

During the last seven years, H.E. T'ai Situ Rinpoche has founded a monastery in northern India and has taught extensively in the Far East, Europe, and especially in North America. Because of his youthfulness, excellent command of English, and his fine sense of humor, Rinpoche is very popular with Western audiences.

We are honored by Rinpoche's visit, and urge anyone interested in Buddhism, ecumenism or world peace to attend these events.
