## Exhibit includes underwater photos

Maude Kerns Art Center will host the works of three artists in an exhibition from June 19-July 19. Oklahoma artist, Nancy Friese will be showing recent paintings, prints and drawings; California artist, Francine Moskovitz will be showing recent "explorations" in underwater photography; Eugene artist, Maureen Culligan will be exhibiting masks and wooden cut outs.

Francine Moskovitz studied photography at Sacramento City College and underwater photography with Jim and Cathy Church of Grand Cayman in British West Indies. She has a bachelor's degree from the University of California at Berkeley.

Moskovitz is exploring two directions in her use of underwater photography: one in which she is using floating objects and dealing with textural contrast; the other, in which she is using models and incorporating re-

flective distortions that "allow the viewer to ponder the thoughts or feelings of the subjects."

Nancy Friese received her Master's of Fine Arts degree from Yale University. She also studied at the University of California at Berkeley and the Art Academy of Cincinnati. Friese received a BS from the University of Tulsa and has been an associate professor there since 1983.

Friese works in a variety of mediums including drawing, printmaking and oils. Currently, Friese is concentrating on oils. In speaking of her work, she says, "My works are from the landscape theme and try to capture the always changing sense of life and color of nature through formal

elements and personal vision."

Maureen Culligan is best known for the masks she's created and marketed through her business, Mask Hysteria Inc. Culligan describes herself as "a self taught artist whose masks evoke more than they conceal." She is currently working on acrylic portraits and painted wooden cut outs on the themes of saints, angels, and the Madonna and Child.

An opening reception will be held Friday, June 19, from 7-9 pm at Maude Kerns Art Center, 1910 East 15th Avenue in Eugene. The Andre St. James jazz trio will provide listening and dancing entertainment. The public is welcome. Admission is free. For more information call 345-1571.

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
