Stoneware, watercolors

Opus 5 Gallery will host a reception Thursday, July 9, for Eugene artists Lotte Streisinger and Nancy Holzhauser, whose stoneware and watercolor exhibits are on display there. The reception is from 5:30-7:30 pm.

Masks and Jesters—New Images in Stoneware is the title of Streisinger's exhibit. Their forms are functional vases, platters, tiles and candle holders, which in their decorative designs carry out the theme of masks and jesters. This theme represents a longtime interest of Streisinger's in masks. It was her idea to incorporate the friezes of masks that decorate the Hult Center lobbies when she was coordinating the art selection for that building. The masks used on her pieces are inspired by classic mask designs, by the masks of local mask maker, Maureen Culligan, and by the masks she saw while on a recent trip to Venice.

"Expressionistic landscape watercolors" is what Holzhauser calls her newest exhibit, *Mountain Impressions*. All of the paintings were done in and around the Three Fingered Jack, Jefferson Wilderness Area. A former biologist for the U.S. Forest Service at McKenzie Bridge, Holz-

hauser has brought her love for nature to her watercolors. "I am aware that as I compose my paintings I am making a subtle statement about my respect for the natural world based on my past experience," she says. "I hope to communicate the importance of living in balance with all the com-

ponents of nature that are so easy to forget in our daily lives."

Both exhibits will be on display July 6 through August 8. Opus 5 Gallery is located at 136 East Broadway between Oak and Pearl Streets. Regular hours are 10 am to 5:30 pm, Mondays through Saturdays.
