Small businesses savor success

Is success living out a lifelong dream, or is it finding a way to make money by meeting a need in your community? The owners of three small but growing Eugene businesses answer that question in unique but mentionable ways.

Nikki and David Winchell opened Winchell's SweatShop a little over a year ago and began to experience that modicum of success indicated by a steady return of satisfied customers. When the spot next to Pedal Power near the U of O campus opened up, with a room upstairs that could be turned into a dance studio, they moved their store and more into **Dance City Sweats**. So now, in addition to their large selection of sweats (23 colors), they also stock what David refers to as "full-tilt dance-wear." In the two months since they moved they have quadrupled their

sales and built a beautiful, maple-floored dance studio where Nikki and some other of Eugene's hot dance teachers offer a wide array of classes. In their spare time, David and his son Brady have begun designing original tee's and sweatshirts (one for Nuclear Free Zone, and one for Roboduck). If you have spare time this week you may want to stop in and check out their Grand Opening Celebration from November 18 through the week-end.

Gary Dawson is a native Oregonian who's worked with metals all his life, from welding as a kid growing up on a farm to learning jewelry design from Max Nixon (progenitor of several well-known Eugene jewelers) while an Anthropology student at the University. Some of his current customers at **Goldworks**, a custom-design jewelry studio at 15th and

Willamette, might not recognize him as the young man with hair down to his waist who learned marketing while selling his work door to door at business and doctors' offices and sat in Max's Tavern with his box of jewelry and a flashlight. He's also sold at crafts fairs up and down the West Coast. In fact, he met his wife Eileen who now does the silver work, strings the beads, and keeps the books at the **Portland Saturday Market**. Gary says of his work, "I love metal because it's the ideal medium. You can stretch it, bend it, pour it, break it, weld it. Anything goes with metal—it's never ruined."

Kuraya DeGraaf has experienced success at each of the three Thai restaurants she started before opening **Kuraya's Thai Cuisine** in Springfield. She grew up cooking as part of a traditional Thai family in which children are expected to work. Now she lives out her belief in making each dish special. People interested in experiencing a new taste in oriental cuisine will find the trip to her pleasantly-decorated, spacious restaurant on Mohawk Blvd. in Springfield well worth repeating.
